Brokens: Well made good liquoring types sold well at rates of Tk 5/8 easier than last. Mediums met with only a fair demand but eased by Tk 5/7. Plainer types witnessed limited demand and majority remained unsold.

Fannings: Best and below best met with a fairly good demand and sold at rates Tk 5/7 below last. Mediums eased about similarly. Plainer types were a weaker market and mostly remained unsold.
