LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: Well made good liquoring descriptions met with good demand at firm to occasionally dearer rates following competition. Mediums witnessed an improved demand generally around previous levels. Plain and poorer sorts met with selective demand at further discounted rates with large withdrawals.

Fannings: Well made bright liquoring types were a good market and sold at generally firm to little dearer rates than last. Mediums met with some inquiry and mostly held firm on last. Limited weight of plainer types were sold at further easier levels with substantial withdrawals.
