Brokens: Clean good liquoring types met with a fairly strong demand and sold at firm to occasionally little dearer rates. Others met with selective demand and generally eased in value. Plainer types were neglected whilst those at the lower end of the market met with some interest.

Fannings: Likewise, best and the below best types met with a fairly strong demand and sold at firm to little dearer rates. Rest met with irregular demand at easier rates. Poorer types met with only a fair demand.
