LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: Select few best types sold well at firm to little dearer rates. Others were generally firm on last. Plainer types met with a fair demand at firm to occasionally slightly dearer rates following quality. Poorer types were neglected.

Fannings: Best types were readily absorbed at firm rates. Others were irregularly little easier. Plain and the poorer types met with selective interest at firm to little easier rates and there were large withdrawals.
