LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: Expensive lines witnessed a substantial decline often by Tk 15/20 with some withdrawals. Others were easier by Tk. 10/15. Medium and Plainer types shed similarly with fair withdrawals.

Fannings: Clean well made types sold well but eased by Tk. 10/15. Medium and plainer types declined by around Tk 10/= and there were fair withdrawals.

Dust: Cleaner RD's and Dusts sold well at rates Tk 15/20 below last. Others met with a selective demand at similarly easier rates and suffered fair withdrawals. Cleaner CD's were a fairly strong feature.

Comment: This sale was held after two weeks owing to Eid-ul-Fitr holidays. This week's Tea Auction was again held at the Bangabandhu Conference Hall of the Chattogram World Trade Centre in order to fulfill the compliances necessitated due to the Covid-19 pandemic. Offerings witnessed a fairly good demand with Buyers following quality. Prices declined further and a fair weight, especially the medium and plainer types, were withdrawn without registering any bids.
