<u>Brokens:</u> Well made good liquoring types were readily absorbed at around last levels. Below best and the Mediums met with a fair demand at rates Tk. 3/5 easier than last. Plainer descriptions met with selective demand at further discounted rates. Withdrawals were substantial in this category.

<u>Fannings:</u> Best and below best types met with fairly good demand but eased by Tk. 3/4 from last. Mediums met with only a fair interest at levels Tk 2/5 below last following quality. Plainer sorts were difficult of sale.
