**Brokens:** Best and the below best types sold well at firm rates. Mediums were firm to occasionally little dearer. Plainer types met with an improved demand and were generally dearer than last.

**Fannings:** Clean good liquoring types sold readily at firm rates. Occasional lines tended slightly dearer following competition. Mediums held on to last rates whilst plainer types met with a fairly strong demand and often appreciated in value.

**Dust:** Met with a strong demand. Prices for most descriptions were firm to occasionally dearer by upto Tk. 5/=. CD's were a strong feature.
