Buyers: Blenders as well as the Loose Tea Traders were less active than last.

LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: Well made good liquoring types sold fairly well but prices were generally Tk 3/5 lower last. Mediums met with much less demand and eased about similarly. Plainer types shed a little more following quality.

Fannings: Best and the below best types met with a fair demand and sold at rates Tk 3/5 below last and occasionally more. Others eased similarly.

Dust: Met with a good demand. Most well made good liquoring RD's and Dusts sold well at around last levels whilst CD's were well absorbed at generally between Tk 220/265 per kg. following quality. Blenders and the Loose Tea Traders were active.

Comment: There was less demand for the teas offered this week following reduced support from the Blenders as well as the Loose Tea Traders. Prices for most descriptions as such, declined by Tk 3/5 below last and occasionally more. Withdrawals were fairly large particularly in the Leaf Catalogue. Dusts however, were a good market.
