## LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: Well made good liquoring types met with a fairly strong demand and sold at firm to occasionally little dearer rates. Mediums were generally firm. Plainer types met with a good demand at around last levels.

Fannings: Best types were a fairly strong market and sold at firm to irregularly slightly dearer rates following quality. Others mostly held on to last rates. Plainer types were a fairly good market and generally sold at firm levels.
