LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: Well made good liquoring types were readily absorbed mainly by the Blenders at firm to little easier rates of Tk 2/3. Below best types sold about similarly. Mediums were firm to occasionally little easier following quality. Plainer types were about steady.

Fannings: Best and the below best types were a good market and sold well at rates Tk 2/3 easier than last. Others met with a fair demand at similarly easier rates. Plainer types were firm to little easier.

Dust: Met with a fairly good demand. Clean well made RD and Dusts mostly sold at around last levels whilst others ruled easier by Tk. 2/3. Cleaner CD's were a good market at around last rates with the lesser types being neglected.

Comment: Offering witnessed a good demand mainly from the Blenders and sold at rates firm to little easier following quality. Loose Tea Traders were apparently a little more active than last. Clean good liquoring types continued to be the major attraction. There were however, some withdrawals. Teas from the Northern district continued to sell well except for the very plain/poorer types which mostly remained unsold.
