<u>Brokens:</u> Well made good liquoring types sold well but shed Tk 3/5 from last. Below best and the mediums met with a fair demand at easier rates of Tk 2/3. Plainer types met with less demand and where sold, eased by Tk 3/5 from last.

<u>Fannings:</u> Best and the below best types were absorbed mainly by the Blenders at rates Tk 3/5 easier than last. Mediums met with a fair demand at easier rates of Tk 2/3 whilst plainer types were easier by Tk 3/5 with fairly large withdrawals.

<u>Dust:</u> Met with a weaker market and prices were all-round easier with considerable withdrawals. A few lines of clean good liquoring CD's were firm whilst others were easier and mostly remained unsold.

<u>Comment:</u> This sale witnessed the largest offering so far this season. Blenders continued to be the major contenders with only a fair support from the Loose Tea Traders. Clean good liquoring types sold well but shed more whilst others met with only a fair demand. A substantial weight however, remained unsold owing to lack of demand.
