Buyers: Blenders were the major contenders. Loose Tea Traders were a little less active than last.

LEAF-CTC:

<u>Brokens:</u> Clean good liquoring types sold readily at about firm rates. Select few lines tended slightly dearer following competition. Mediums mostly held firm on last whilst plainer types were firm to irregularly slightly dearer with quality. Poorer types were neglected.

<u>Fannings:</u> Met with a good demand at generally around last levels. Best and the below best types were firm to occasionally a shade dearer. Others sold well at about firm rates. Plainer types were steady.

<u>Dust:</u> Met with a fairly good market at easier rates of Tk. 3/5 from last. Select few popular well made types however, were firm. Cleaner CD's sold well whilst secondary types were mostly neglected.

<u>Comment:</u> Offerings witnessed a good demand at levels mostly around last. Blenders were the major outlets. Loose Tea Traders were apparently a little less active than last. Dusts met with a fairly good demand especially the clean good liquoring type. Poorer sorts were generally neglected.
