<u>Demand:</u> Good demand at generally little easier rates.

<u>Buyers:</u> Blenders operated actively. Loose Tea Traders were rather selective.

LEAF-CTC:

<u>Brokens:</u> Well-made, good liquoring types were absorbed by the Blenders at firm to slightly easier rates. Below best and mediums sold at easier rates of Tk 1/2. Plainer types sold about similarly with some withdrawals.

<u>Fannings:</u> Best types sold well at firm to generally little easier rates. Others met with fair demand at rates Tk 1/2 below last. Plainer types witnessed some withdrawals.

<u>Dust:</u> Clean, good liquoring sorts met with fairly good demand at generally firm rates. Others were firm to easier by Tk 2/3 following quality.

<u>Comment:</u> Apart from the select few best types which were about firm, others were generally a little easier. Packeteers continued to be the major contenders. Loose Tea Traders lacked strength. There were, however, some withdrawals.
