Quality: Showed a little decline.

Demand: Less demand at further lower rates.

<u>Buyers:</u> Blenders lent fair support whilst Loose Tea Traders showed limited interest for the cheaper varieties.

LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: Select few popular well made types sold well at about firm rates. All others were easier by Tk. 5/7 and often more with fairly large withdrawals. Teas from the Northern District met with selective interest at drops of Tk. 8/10 from last.

<u>Fannings:</u> Likewise, a limited weight of popular well made types sold well at about firm rates. Rest met with much less demand at rates easier by Tk 5/7 and often more. Teas from the Northern District shed more and suffered large withdrawals.

<u>Dust:</u> Clean good liquoring types met with a fairly good demand and sold at firm to little easier rates than last. Rest were easier with substantial withdrawals.

<u>Comment:</u> Market opened with a fairly good demand mainly from the Blenders which, however, slackened as sale progressed leading to further lower price levels and heavy withdrawals. A limited weight of popular well made types however, were a good market at about firm levels. Loose Tea Traders were selective.
