Quality: Seasonal, generally plain.

Demand: Good demand for the clean well made types. Others met with only a fair demand.

Buyers: Blenders lent good support whilst Loose Tea Traders continued to operate rather selectively.

LEAF-CTC:

<u>Brokens:</u> A smaller weight of well made good liquoring types available sold well at mostly firm rates. Below best and mediums were easier by Tk 3/5. Plainer types met with less demand at easier rates and suffered large withdrawals.

Fannings: A small weight of best and the below best types offered sold readily at generally firm to occasionally slightly dearer rates. Others were easier with fair withdrawals.

<u>Dust:</u> Clean good liquoring descriptions were well competed for by the Blenders and the Loose Tea Traders and sold at firm to little dearer rates. Others were firm. Plainer types were easier with fair withdrawals.

<u>Comment:</u> The small weight of the clean good liquoring types available were keenly sought after by all sections of the market and sold at firm rates. Rest met with a fair demand at easier rates with fairly large withdrawals. Dust followed the trend of the Leaf market.
