Quality: Mostly plain and end season type.

<u>Demand:</u> Limited demand at easier rates with fairly large withdrawals.

Buyers: Blenders were selective whilst Loose Tea Traders were rather subdued.

LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: A handful of cleaner types available met with a fair demand and sold at barely firm to generally easier rates with some withdrawals. All others met with restricted demand at easier rates with a large weight remaining unsold.

<u>Fannings:</u> Likewise, a small weight of the better types offered met with a fairly good demand at firm to little easier rates. Rest met with selective demand at easier rates and suffered fairly large withdrawals.

<u>Dust:</u> Select few well made, popular types sold well at around last levels. Rest met with only selective demand at heavily discounted rates and suffered considerable withdrawals. CDs were easier.

<u>Comment:</u> Offering witnessed a constricted demand following reduced interest from the major Blenders and very selective demand from the Loose Tea Traders. As a result, prices declined further this week with considerable withdrawals.
