Demand: Limited demand at easier rates with fairly large withdrawals.

Buyers: Blenders were selective whilst Loose Tea Traders were rather subdued.

LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: A handful of cleaner types available met with a fair demand and sold at barely firm to generally easier rates with some withdrawals. All others met with restricted demand at easier rates with a large weight remaining unsold.

Fannings: Likewise, a small weight of the better types offered met with a fairly good demand at firm to little easier rates. Rest met with selective demand at easier rates and suffered fairly large withdrawals.
