<u>Buyers:</u> Blenders lifted a fair weight whilst Loose Tea Traders were rather selective.

LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: A handful of cleaner types on offer sold well at about firm to generally easier rates of Tk 3/5. Rest met with a fair demand at levels of around Tk. 5/= below last.

<u>Fannings:</u> A limited weight of the good liquoring types met with a fair demand and sold at slightly easier rates. Medium and the plainer types met with some interest but at easier rates with some withdrawals.
