LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: Well made good liquoring types sold well at firm rates. Below best and mediums sold about similarly. Plainer types were a little easier and there were some withdrawals.

Fannings: Clean good liquoring types met with a good demand and generally sold at firm levels. Select few best types were a little dearer. Mediums met with a fairly good demand and mostly held on to last rates. Plainer types were irregularly little easier.

Bought-Leaf Teas: Met with a fair demand at levels generally between Tk 130/144. Brown, poorer types were however, neglected.
