Quality: Fairly useful.

Demand: Good demand at generally firm rates.

Buyers: Blenders lent useful support. Loose Tea Traders were apparently less active than last.

LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: Well made good liquoring types sold readily at generally firm rates. Select few lines of best types occasionally tended dearer. Mediums sold well at firm to irregularly little easier rates. Plainer types were easier with some withdrawals.

Fannings: Best and the below best types were a good market and generally sold at firm rates. Mediums met with a fairly good demand at around last levels. Plainer types were little easier.

Bought-Leaf Teas: Met with a limited demand at easier rates generally selling between Tk 125/138.

Dust: Clean good liquoring types met with a fairly strong demand and sold at firm to occasionally little dearer rates. Rests were generally firm to little easier with quality. Plainer types were easier. Cleaner CD's sold well.

<u>Comment:</u> Well made good liquoring types attracted widespread interest and sold well at mostly firm rates. Others met with a fairly good demand. Plainer types were easier. Blenders were the major contenders whilst support from the Loose Tea Traders was little less than last.
