Brokens: Most well made good liquoring types met with a good market and sold at firm rates. Select few lines of popular best types were a little dearer. Mediums mostly held on to last rates whilst plainer types tended easier.

Fannings: Best and the below best types sold well at rates generally around last. Select few lines were slightly dearer following competition. Rest were firm. Plainer types were often a little easier.

Bought-Leaf Teas: Met with a fairly good demand and mostly sold between Tk 120/140 following quality.

Comment: Demand pattern was quite similar to last whereby well made bright liquoring descriptions were keenly sought after by all sections of the market. Others met with a fair demand. Plainer sorts were generally little easier. Dusts were a good market. There were however, a few withdrawals.
