Quality: About maintained.

Demand: Good demand at firm to little easier rates following quality.

Buyers: Blenders were the major contenders with fair interest from the Loose Tea Traders.

LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: Well made good liquoring types sold readily at around last rates. A few lines inclined following competition. Below best and the mediums were steady to often slightly easier. Plainer types were irregularly little easier.

Fannings: Best types sold well at rates generally firm on last. Rest were firm to irregularly little easier following quality. Plainer types sold at around last levels.

Bought-Leaf Teas: Fairly good demand and sold at levels mostly between Tk. 110/140. Select few lines however, fetched more.
