Brokens: Well made good liquoring types sold well at firm rates. Mediums were firm to little easier following quality. Brown plainer types were neglected and where sold, were discounted.

Fannings: Best and the below best types were a fairly strong market and mostly sold at firm rates. Mediums were steady to little easier with quality. Plain and the poorer types were often difficult of sale.

Bought-Leaf Teas: Met with fair demand at around last levels. There were however, some withdrawals in this category.
