Quality: About maintained.

Demand: Good demand. Clean well made types were a strong feature.

Buyers: Blenders were active. Loose Tea Traders lent good support.

LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: Well made good liquoring types met with a strong demand and generally ruled firm on last. Below best and the mediums were a steady market. Plain and the poorer types met with less demand and suffered fair withdrawals.

Fannings: Best and below best types were well competed for by all sections of the market and sold at firm rates. Mediums held on to last levels. Plain and the poor types were easier and often neglected.

Bought-Leaf Teas: Less demand at easier rates with large withdrawals.

Dust: Clean well made types sold readily at around last levels. Rest were easier by Tk 3/5. Brown, fibrous types were neglected. Cleaner CD's were a strong feature.

Comment: There was sustained demand for the cleaner types on offer which generally sold at around last levels. Others met with a fairly good market. Brown, lighter teas were neglected. Teas from the Bought Leaf Factories met with less demand and consequently suffered fairly large withdrawals.
