Quality: Fair.

Demand: Good demand at generally easier rates.

Buyers: Blenders were the major contenders but were less forceful than last. Loose Tea Traders lent fair support.

LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: Clean good liquoring types sold well at firm to upto Tk. 5/= easier than last. Others shed Tk 5/7. Plainer types suffered fair withdrawals.

Fannings: Clean well made types were a good market but eased by about Tk. 5/= from last. Medium shed a little more. Plainer types were easier with fair withdrawals.

Bought-Leaf Teas: Met with a fair demand at around last levels. There were however, some withdrawals.

Dust: Clean good liquoring types sold well at easier rates of Tk.5/10 from last. Others shed similarly and occasionally more. CD's were a good market particularly the cleaner types.

Comment: Clean good liquoring types continued to sell well whilst others met with a somewhat less demand and suffered fair withdrawals. Prices were generally easier. Occasional lines tended firm. Blenders apparently were less forceful whilst Loose Tea Traders lifted only a fair weight. Plain poorer types continued to be neglected.
