Quality: Barely maintained.

Demand: Good demand with Buyers following quality.

Buyers: Blenders accounted for most of the teas sold. Loose Tea Traders lent a fair support.

LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: Clean good liquoring types sold readily at levels generally around last. Below best types were barely steady. Medium and the plainer types eased by around Tk. 5/= with some withdrawals.

Fannings: Best types were a fairly strong feature and generally sold at firm rates. Below best were steady. Rest were firm to little easier following quality.

Bought-Leaf Teas: Only a fair demand at around last rates. There were fair withdrawals.

Dust: Neat good liquoring types sold well at firm to often easier rates of Tk 5/7. Others were easier by Tk 5/10 with some withdrawals. Plainer types were often neglected.

Comment: Blenders continued to be the major outlets but followed quality closely. Apart from the brighter sorts, prices were generally easier. Poorer types were mostly neglected. Dusts were an easier market.
