Buyers: A few of the major blenders lent fair support. Loose Tea Traders were selective.

LEAF-CTC:

Brokens Better types met with a fairly good demand at easier rates of Tk. 10/15. Others met with only a limited demand at drops of Tk. 15/20 and a fair weight remained unsold.

Fannings: Select few cleaner types sold well at easier rates of Tk. 10/15. Rest shed more and suffered fairly large withdrawals.

Bought-Leaf Teas: Met with a limited demand at easier rates of Tk 8/10. A large weight however, were withdrawn without any bids.
