LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: Select few best types sold well at generally firm to little dearer rates. Below best and the mediums were firm to little easier following quality. Plain types were little easier.

Fannings: A small weight of the best types offered were readily absorbed at firm to little dearer rates. Others were firm to little easier with quality. Plain types were generally little easier.

Bought-Leaf Teas: Met with a limited demand at little easier rates.
