Quality: Barely maintained.

Demand: Less demand at easier rates.

Buyers: Packeteers were the major contenders. Loose Tea Traders operated selectively.

LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: Better types met with a good demand and sold at rates Tk. 8/10 lower than last. Others met with selective demand at similarly easier rates. There were substantial withdrawals especially in the plainer category.

Fannings: Clean good liquoring sorts were readily absorbed at levels generally Tk 8/10 below last. Below best and mediums met with a fair demand at rates easier by around Tk 10/= . Plainer types were generally neglected.

Bought-Leaf Teas: Met with a limited demand. Prices generally ranged between Tk 110/125. Select few lines fetched a little more. Withdrawals were heavy in this category
