Quality: Barely maintained.

Demand: Fair demand at generally easier rates with Buyers following quality.

Buyers: Blenders continued to be the major out-lets. Loose Tea Traders lent fair support.

LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: Met with a fair demand at generally easier rates of Tk. 3/5. There were fairly large withdrawals especially in the medium and plainer category.

Fannings: Best and the below best types met with a fairly good demand and sold at rates Tk. 3/5 below last. Rest met with less demand and suffered fair withdrawals.

Bought-Leaf Teas: Met with selective demand and generally sold at between Tk. 100/115. Select few better types fetched between Tk. 120/135.
