Quality: Similar to last.

Demand: Less demand at reduced levels with heavier withdrawals.

Buyers: Blenders were fairly active whilst Loose Tea Traders were selective.

LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: A limited weight of good liquoring types met with a fair demand at firm to easier rates following quality. Medium and plainer descriptions witnessed less demand at easier levels and suffered large withdrawals.

Fannings: A handful of clean, good liquoring descriptions were generally absorbed at around last levels. Others met with a limited demand at rates Tk. 3/5 easier than last with substantial withdrawals.

Bought-Leaf Teas: Met with less demand at further easier rates than last.

Dust: Met with a fair demand. Select few better types met with a fairly good market and sold at about firm to little easier rates following quality. Others met with selective demand and suffered fair withdrawals.

Comment: Market was weaker than last. Blenders were the major contenders and accounted for most of the teas sold. Loose Tea Traders were selective. Plain and re-print teas continued to be neglected.
