Buyers: Blenders were active whilst Loose Tea Traders lent fair support.

LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: Well-made, good liquoring types met with at good demand at rates generally little easier than last. Others met with a fair demand at rates Tk. 3/5 easier. There were however, some withdrawals.

Fannings: Clean good liquoring sorts sold well at rates firm to little easier than last. Mediums met with a similar market. Plainer sorts witnessed selective demand at easier rates with fair withdrawals.

Bought-Leaf Teas: Met with a little improved demand. Prices generally ranged between 100/125 and occasionally a little more following quality.

Dust: Met with an improved demand. Cleaner types were firm to dearer following competition. Others were about firm. Plainer types were neglected. Colory CDs were a strong feature.

Comment: A limited weight of well-made good liquoring types on offer met with a good demand. Prices for most descriptions were generally easier than last. Larger grades met with less demand. Packeteers continue to be the major contenders. Plainer types mostly remained unsold.
