Buyers: Blenders were the major contenders. Loose Tea Traders were rather subdued.

LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: A handful of well-made good liquoring types on offer, sold well at about firm rates. Others met with a limited demand at easier rates and a large weight remained unsold.

Fannings: A nominal weight of clean good liquoring types available, sold well at about firm rates. Rests were easier and suffered heavy withdrawals.

Bought-Leaf Teas: Met with only a limited demand at easier rates withdrawals were heavy. Prices generally ranged between Tk. 90/125 following quality.
