Buyers: Blenders lent fairly good support. Loose Tea Traders were selective.

LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: A small weight of well-made good liquoring types on offer sold well at about firm to little easier rates. Mediums met with fair interest and sold at easier rates of Tk. 3/5. Plain and the poorer types were neglected.

Fannings: A handful of bright liquoring types offered sold readily at around last levels. Others met with only a fair demand at easier rates with considerable withdrawals.

Bought-Leaf Teas: Met with less demand at further easier rates. Withdrawals were substantial. Prices generally ranged between Tk. 80/125 following quality.

Dust: Met with fairly good demand. Brighter liquoring types sold well at about firm rates. Others met with a fair demand at easier rates. CDs were a good market but eased in value.

Comment: Better liquoring types were a good market whilst others were easier and suffered large withdrawals. Blenders continue to be fairly active whilst Loose Tea Traders operated selectively. Plain and re-printed teas were again neglected.
