Quality: Fair.

Demand: Fair demand.

Buyers: Blenders were the major contenders. Loose Tea Traders were rather selective.

LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: Select few lines of well made good liquoring types offered sold well at around last levels. Others were easier and suffered fair withdrawals. Plainer types met with a poor demand and where sold, were heavily discounted.

Fannings: A limited weight of brighter liquoring types available sold well at around last levels. Rest met with only a fair demand at little easier rates and a fair weight remained unsold.

Bought-Leaf Teas: Less demand at further lower rates with heavy withdrawals. Prices generally ranged between Tk. 70/110 and occasionally a little more following quality.

Dust: Met with a fair demand and mostly sold at easier rates. Prices were generally lower by Tk. 5/10 from last and occasionally more. There were fair withdrawals.

Comment: Offering continue to be large comprising a considerable weight of plain and re-printed teas. Better types sold well whilst others met with a limited demand and suffered heavy withdrawals. Dusts were an easier market.
