Buyers: Blenders lent fair support. Loose Tea Traders were selective.

LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: A nominal weight of the better liquoring types offered sold well at generally around last levels. Others met with only a fair demand at little easier rates. A large weight however, remained unsold owing to lack of interest. Plain and poorer types were mostly neglected.

Fannings: A small weight of the clean good liquoring types available met with a fairly good market at about firm rates. Rest were easier with fairly large withdrawals.

Bought-Leaf Teas: Poor demand at easier rates with heavy withdrawals.
