Buyers: Blenders lent good support. Loose Tea Traders lifted only a fair weight.

LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: Good liquoring types offered met with keen interest from all sections of the market and sold at firm to occasionally slightly improved rates. Others were generally little easier and suffered large withdrawals.

Fannings: Clean bright liquoring types offered met with a ready market and sold at firm rates. Rests were easier and a large weight remained unsold.

Bought-Leaf Teas: Met with selective demand at generally around last levels. There were however, heavy withdrawals.
