Quality: Similar to last.

**Demand:** Better demand for good liquoring types. Rest met with only a fair demand.

**Buyers:** Blenders were active whilst the Loose Tea Traders lent selective support.

## LEAF-CTC:

**Brokens:** A small weight of well made brighter liquoring types available met with a fairly strong demand and sold at firm to little dearer rates. Rest met with only a fair demand at around last levels. Plainer types were generally neglected.

**Fannings:** A limited weight of clean good liquoring types offered were much sought after by all sections of the market and generally sold at firm to little dearer rates. Mediums met with a fair demand at around last levels. Plainer types were mostly withdrawn without any bids.

**Bought-Leaf Teas**: Only a fair demand at around last levels with heavy withdrawals.

**<u>Dust</u>**: Clean good liquoring types sold well at firm to little easier rates. Others were generally easier with fair withdrawals. CD's were mostly easier.

**<u>Comment</u>**: Well made good liquoring types met with an improved demand and ruled firm to dearer. Rest mostly held on to last levels. Plain and re-printed teas continue to suffer heavy withdrawals.
