Demand: Improved demand at generally firm to little dearer rates following quality.

Buyers: Blenders were the major contenders with fair interest from the Loose Tea Traders.

LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: Better types sold well at firm rates. Occasional lines were dearer following quality. Below best and the mediums were about steady. Plainer types met with selective interest at around last levels.

Fannings: Select few best types offered sold readily at firm to little dearer rates. Others were a fair market at about firm rates. Plainer types met with only selective interest.

Bought-Leaf Teas: Met with a slightly improved demand at generally firm to little dearer rates. There were however, substantial withdrawals.

Dust: Select few clean good liquoring types offered sold well at firm to little dearer rates. Others met with selective interest at easier rates with many withdrawals.

Comment: There was apparently an improved demand for the reduced weight on offer this week which sold at levels generally firm on last. A limited weight of clean good liquoring types available appreciated in value. Withdrawals were substantial and were confined mostly in the medium and plainer category.
