Buyers: Blenders operated in better strength. Loose Tea Traders were active.

LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: Well made good liquoring types were a strong feature and appreciated in value following competition. Below best and the mediums were also a good market and ruled dearer. Plainer types were about steady with some withdrawals.

Fannings: Best and the below best types were a strong market and sold at dearer rates of Tk. 5/7 and often more following competition. Rest were firm with some withdrawals especially in the plainer category.

Bought-Leaf Teas: Met with a good demand and generally sold at dearer rates. There were however, some withdrawals.
