Quality: Shows some decline.

Demand: Less demand at easier rates with heavy withdrawals.

Buyers: Blenders were less active. Loose Tea Traders were rather selective. Buyers for Pakistan lifted a limited weight.

LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: Better liquoring types met with a fair demand at easier rates of Tk. 3/5 from last with some withdrawals. Others met with only a limited demand at easier rates with fairly large withdrawals.

Fannings: Likewise, clean good liquoring sorts met with only a fair demand at easier rates. Rest met with selective interest at lower rates and suffered considerable withdrawals.

Bought-Leaf Teas: Only a fair demand. Select few better liquoring types fetched between Tk. 115/130 whilst others sold at between Tk. 75/105 per kg.
