Brokens: Well made good liquoring types sold well at levels little lower than last following quality. Below best at the mediums sold readily at around last levels.

Fannings: Best and the below best types were well supported by the Blenders followed by the Loose Tea Traders and sold at rates generally little lower than last. Medium sold well at mostly firm rates.

Bought-Leaf Teas: Met with strong demand at firm to dearer rates. Blenders absorbed the bulk of the offering.
